

**ORDINANCE # O-103-2014**

**AN ORDINANCE REGARDING THE PLACEMENT AND REMOVAL OF WASTE RECEPTACLES WITHIN THE VILLAGE; ESTABLISHING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Village Council has received numerous complaints from residents regarding other residents leaving out waste receptacles permanently and not taking them in and out for trash day of each week;

WHEREAS, the Village Council notes that this is a potential health and safety hazard for our residents;

WHEREAS, the Village Council of the Village of Bolivar, Ohio, believes that this practice of leaving waste receptacles out permanently should be stopped immediately due to the risks it poses to the Village.

Now, therefore be it ordained by the Village Council the Village of Bolivar, Ohio, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** The Village Council for the Village of Bolivar hereby provides that waste receptacles should be placed outside no earlier than 24 hours before trash pickup is scheduled at a given location, and that the waste receptacles must be removed by sunrise the day after trash pickup. Waste receptacles must be stored either inside the garage on the property, or directly alongside the building on the property when not placed out for collection under these parameters.

**SECTION 2.** If the owner, occupant or any other person, firm or corporation, in control of the waste receptacles fails to comply with this Ordinance, the Village may issue them a ticket with a fine of up to \$15.00 per occurrence.

**SECTION 3.** This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and its passage is immediately necessary in order to preserve, protect, and maintain health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Bolivar, Ohio, to eliminate the potential liability to the Village during the tax season which is currently going on, and therefore the same shall be in full force and effect immediately.
