

**RESOLUTION R-15-2016  
VILLAGE OF BOLIVAR**

A RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO LEVY A TAX IN EXCESS OF  
THE TEN MILL LIMITATION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

REV. CODE, SECS. 5705.19, .191, .192, .194, .21, .26

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL FOR THE VILLAGE OF BOLIVAR OF TUSCARAWAS  
COUNTY, OHIO MET IN A REGULAR SESSION ON THE 6TH DAY OF JUNE,  
2016 AT THE VILLAGE HALL WITH THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS PRESENT:

Member Lapp moved the adoption of the following Resolution:

**WHEREAS**, the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of said Village of Bolivar, Tuscarawas County, Ohio; therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**, By the Village Council of the Village of Bolivar, Tuscarawas County, Ohio two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring, that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten mill limitation for the benefit of the Village of Bolivar, Tuscarawas County, Ohio, for the purposes of providing for the street construction projects the Village of Bolivar at a rate not exceeding 2.9 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.29 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a renewal of an existing levy of 2.9 mills commencing in 2017 and first due in calendar year 2018. Said levy shall be a renewal of an existing levy and shall be renewed for a period of five (5) years pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 5705.19(G)

**RESOLVED**, That the question of levying the renewal taxes be submitted to the electors of said Village of Bolivar at the general election to be held at the usual voting place within said Village of Bolivar on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2016; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that said levy be placed upon the tax list of the current year after the February settlement next succeeding the election, if the majority of the electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that the Fiscal Officer of the Village of Bolivar be and is hereby directed to certify a copy of this resolution to the Board of Elections of Tuscarawas County Ohio, 90 days prior to the election upon which it will be voted, and to notify said Board of Elections to cause notice of election on the question of levying said tax to be given as required by law.
