

ORDINANCE # O-18-2017

AN ORDINANCE TO HIRE CHARLES D. WILLIAMS II AS AN INDEPENDENT CONSULTANT FOR THE VILLAGE IN THE POSITION OF WATER ADMINISTRATOR; ESTABLISHING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Charles D. Williams II has been providing water operator services for the Village of Bolivar;

WHEREAS, the Village Council of the Village of Bolivar, Ohio, has a need for continuing these services to fulfill the Village's water system testing responsibilities and ensuring the water system is operational;

WHEREAS, The Village of Bolivar wishes to hire Mr. Williams as an independent contractor/consultant to provide water operator services for the Village of Bolivar;

WHEREAS, Mr. Williams shall work on an as-needed basis performing water checks required by the EPA for the Village of Bolivar and running the Village water system;

WHEREAS, Mr. Williams shall be paid \$700.00 per month for his services, which shall be provided on an as-needed basis to the Village;

WHEREAS, Mr. Williams shall be hired for a term of 1 year from the date hereof as an independent contractor, and shall not be entitled to any benefits from the Village or any contributions to OPERS.

Now, therefore be it ordained by the Village Council the Village of Bolivar, Ohio, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Village Council for the Village of Bolivar hereby approves the hiring of Charles D. Williams II as an independent contractor/consultant for the Village under the aforementioned conditions.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and its passage is immediately necessary in order to preserve, protect, and maintain health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Bolivar, Ohio, to ensure that the Village has a properly certified employee to operate the Village water system and protect the water provided to its citizens and comply with environmental regulations, and therefore the same shall be in full force and effect immediately.
