ORDINANCE # 0-23-2017

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE ADDITIONAL HOURS FOR THE VILLAGE POLICE DEPARTMENT; ESTABLISHING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Police Chief has approached Council regarding the need for the police department to work additional hours per week to cover the many seasonal events that Bolivar has and to ensure that these events run smoothly and have police coverage;

WHEREAS, the Police Chief is asking for the authorization to have the department work 8 additional hours per week over the current allotted hours for the period of each of April 1 to November 1;

WHEREAS, the Village Council of the Village of Bolivar, Ohio, wishes to grant the Police Department the additional hours for the above-stated time only and only if the Village budget permits;

WHEREAS, these extra hours shall be granted to the Police Department as a whole, and it shall be the duty of the Police Chief to decide how to divide those hours among the officers of the Department.

Now, therefore be it ordained by the Village Council the Village of Bolivar, Ohio, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Village Council for the Village of Bolivar hereby authorizes additional hours for the Bolivar Police Department as set forth above.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and its passage is immediately necessary in order to preserve, protect, and maintain health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Bolivar, Ohio, and to provide additional policing for the busier summer months and therefore the same shall be in full force and effect immediately.
