

ORDINANCE # O-17-2018

AN ORDINANCE CONTRACTING WITH GPD GROUP FOR VILLAGE OF BOLIVAR WATER METER PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Bolivar, Ohio is required to update the Village's water system to become metered in order to apply for and receive funds for upcoming water infrastructure projects and in order to sustain the water system going forward into the future;

WHEREAS, the first step in this project is to select a project engineer;

WHEREAS, the Village Council of the Village of Bolivar, Ohio has completed their evaluation of statements of qualification under Ohio's Qualification Based Selection process for engineering firms on public projects, and has properly ranked the candidates pursuant to that process;

WHEREAS, GPD Group was the top-ranked candidate and the Village has been in contract negotiations with this firm since the rankings were issued;

WHEREAS, the parties have reached an agreement on contractual terms for the project, in the form of the attached Exhibit A, being the combined services listed in the proposal.

Now, therefore be it ordained by the Village Council the Village of Bolivar, Ohio, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Village Council for the Village of Bolivar hereby approves the attached contract with GPD Group.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and its passage is immediately necessary in order to preserve, protect, and maintain health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Bolivar, Ohio, and to ensure that the Village can apply for funding in the appropriate timelines to perform much-needed maintenance and upgrades to the water system to protect residents' welfare, and therefore the same shall be in full force and effect immediately.
