

VILLAGE OF BOLIVAR COUNCIL MEETING July 31, 2014

The Bolivar Village Council met in a special session on Thursday, **July 31, 2014**. Mayor Hubble called the meeting to order at 5:36 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was said. Cochran, Lang, Lloyd, Marburger, Slutz & Vincent answered roll call.

The purpose of the special meeting is to approve an amended resolution for the police levy and pass a separate resolution to allow the County Auditor to certify the resolution.

There are no changes in the actual levy, however there was a small typo detected that needed changed.

Lang motioned, seconded by Marburger to suspend the rules. In a roll call vote, all members present voted yes. Vincent moved seconded by Lloyd to approve as an emergency, **Resolution R-17-2014; A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE NECESSITY TO LEVY A TAX IN EXCESS OF THE TEN-MILL LIMITATION.** In a roll call vote, all members present voted yes.

Lang moved, seconded by Lloyd to suspend the rules. In a roll call vote, all members present voted yes. Cochran moved, seconded by Marburger to approve, **Resolution R-18-2014; A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE TUSCARAWAS COUNTY AUDITOR CERTIFY TO COUNCIL CERTAIN INFORMATION PURSUANT TO R.C. 5705.03(B) FOR TAX LEVY PURPOSES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

There being no further business, Marburger moved, seconded by Cochran to adjourn until August 4, 2014. In a roll call vote, all members present voted yes.
