

ORDINANCE # O-43-2016

AN ORDINANCE CONTRACTING WITH THE TUSCARAWAS COUNTY JAIL TO PROVIDE PRISONER HOUSING FOR THE YEAR 2017 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Bolivar, Ohio has an obligations under the Ohio Revised Code to house prisoners who are incarcerated due to violations within the Village;

WHEREAS, the Village of Bolivar does not have a facility which would meet the minimum requirements under the law to house inmates and needs to contract with another entity who can provide appropriate prisoner housing;

WHEREAS, the Village of Bolivar, Ohio, currently has a contract with the Tuscarawas County Jail for the housing of prisoners which expires on December 31, 2016;

WHEREAS, the Village Council of the Village of Bolivar, Ohio, wishes to enter into a new contract with the Tuscarawas County Jail for the year 2017, which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and which involves no cost increase for the year.

Now, therefore be it ordained by the Village Council the Village of Bolivar, Ohio, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Village Council for the Village of Bolivar hereby approves the 2017 contract with the Tuscarawas County Jail for the housing of prisoners.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and its passage is immediately necessary in order to preserve, protect, and maintain health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Bolivar, Ohio, and to ensure that there is no gap in prisoner housing coverage for 2017, and therefore the same shall be in full force and effect immediately.
