

**ORDINANCE # O-8-2018**

**AN ORDINANCE TO ENTER INTO A TRASH COLLECTION CONTRACT FOR THE VILLAGE OF BOLIVAR; ESTABLISHING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Village of Bolivar, Ohio, currently has a contract for trash collection with the Kimble Companies which expires on May 31, 2018;

WHEREAS, the Village Council of the Village of Bolivar, Ohio, has authority to enter into a contract for the collection and removal of garbage and other waste substances pursuant to ORC 3707.43;

WHEREAS, upon proper bidding for this contract, the bids were reviewed and it was determined that Kimble Recycling & Disposal was the lowest and best bidder for the services;

WHEREAS, Kimble has proposed a five year contract in the form of the attached Exhibit A;

WHEREAS, the Village Council wishes to approve this contract upon the terms and conditions contained therein.

Now, therefore be it ordained by the Village Council the Village of Bolivar, Ohio, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** The Village Council for the Village of Bolivar hereby approves entering into the contract with Kimble for trash collection services attached as Exhibit A.

**SECTION 2.** This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and its passage is immediately necessary in order to preserve, protect, and maintain health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Bolivar, Ohio, to ensure that there is a continuity of trash collection services for our residents, and therefore the same shall be in full force and effect immediately.
