

ORDINANCE # O-92-2014

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A RATE INCREASE ON EACH USER'S UTILITY BILL FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING NECESSARY FUNDS FOR THE REFUSE AND RECYCLING COLLECTION; DECLARING AS AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Village of Bolivar to raise revenue for the collection of refuse and recycling provided by Kimble Companies; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to impose the following charges per month on each user's utility bill in order to provide funds sufficient to fund those activities;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Bolivar, Ohio, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the said Village of Bolivar shall impose the following monthly charge on a quarterly basis on each user's utility bill for the collection of refuse and recycling:

\$11.00 per month, billed quarterly in the amount of \$33.00, for residential weekly refuse service and bi-weekly recycling service.

SECTION 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, to the extent of such conflict, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. Wherefore, upon the passage and approval of this ordinance, the billable rate of \$11.00 per month will be retroactive to April 1, 2014.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and its passage is immediately necessary in order to preserve, protect, and maintain health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Bolivar, Ohio, and to provide for revenue to pay for refuse and recycling collection, and therefore this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval.
