

ORDINANCE # O-1-2020

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE VILLAGE OF BOLIVAR TO ENTER INTO THE ATTACHED AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE VILLAGE OF BOLIVAR, OHIO AND THE TUSCARAWAS COUNTY PUBLIC LIBRARY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Village Council of the Village of Bolivar, Ohio as follows:

SECTION 1: WHEREAS, the Mayor of the Village of Bolivar is hereby authorized to enter into the attached agreement pursuant to the terms and conditions of the contract hereto and incorporated herein.

SECTION 2: All Ordinances or Resolutions or parts thereof inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force on January 6, 2020.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and its passage is immediately necessary in order to preserve, protect, and maintain health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Bolivar, Ohio, for the reason that it is necessary for the Village of Bolivar to ensure the welfare of the residents is preserved by maintaining a library branch within the Village. Provided it receives the affirmative two-thirds of the members elected to or appointed to council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval.
