

ORDINANCE # O-2-2020

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FISCAL OFFICER OF THE VILLAGE OF BOLIVAR TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE VILLAGE OF BOLIVAR, OHIO AND THE BOARD OF TUSCARAWAS COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR INMATE HOUSING AT THE TUSCARAWAS COUNTY JAIL, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Village Council of the Village of Bolivar, Ohio as follows:

SECTION 1: The Mayor and Fiscal Officer of the Village of Bolivar are hereby authorized to execute the attached contract for inmate housing at the Tuscarawas County Jail pursuant to the terms and conditions of the contract hereto and incorporated herein.

SECTION 2: All Ordinances or Resolutions or parts thereof inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force on January 1, 2020.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, and its immediate passage is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Bolivar, Ohio, for the reason that it is necessary for the Village of Bolivar to ensure there is no interruption in the inmate housing services provided by the Tuscarawas County Jail. Provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to or appointed to council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval.
