

ORDINANCE #O-20-2020

AN ORDINANCE TO ACCEPT FUNDS RECEIVED FROM THE CORONAVIRUS AID, RELIEF, AND ECONOMIC SECURITY ACT IN COMPLIANCE WITH 42 U.S.C. 801(d) AND ANY APPLICABLE REGULATIONS, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the 133rd Ohio General Assembly has passed H.B. 481, and,

WHEREAS, the Village wishes to adopt the defined terms, to comply with the requirements of H.B. 481.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BOLIVAR, OHIO:

SECTION 1: The Fiscal Officer shall adopt a new fund in the entitled the local coronavirus relief fund, for the purpose of depositing any funds received for that purpose.

SECTION 2: The Village affirms that the funds so received may be expended only to cover costs of the subdivision consistent with the requirements of section 5001 of the "Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act," as described in 42 U.S.C. 801(d), and any applicable regulations.

SECTION 3: All prior Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety of the Village of Bolivar, Ohio. The reason for the emergency is to ensure prompt pursuit of funds to assist in abating the opioid epidemic throughout Ohio.
