

**ORDINANCE O-36- 2020**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE VILLAGE OF BOLIVAR APPROPRIATIONS TO INCREASE THE ENTERPRISE IMPROVEMENT FUND**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BOLIVAR, OHIO:**

This Ordinance is being passed as an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety of the Village of Bolivar, Ohio to ensure the Village can begin receiving COVID-19 reimbursements as soon as possible, and the necessary funds are in order to ensure the timely performance of Village operations and timely payment of Village current expenses and obligations. Provided that this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council, it will take effect and be in full force immediately upon its passage.
