

RESOLUTION R-15-2020

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COVID-19 BUSINESS RELIEF PROGRAM FOR THE VILLAGE OF BOLIVAR

WHEREAS; on March 13, 2020, President Donald Trump declared a national emergency concerning the Novel Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) outbreak; and.

WHEREAS; in Executive Order 2020-01D, Ohio Governor Mike DeWine declared a state of emergency for the entire State of Ohio to protect the well being of the citizens of Ohio from the dangerous effects of COVID-19 and to assist in protecting the lives, safety, and health of the citizens of Ohio; and

WHEREAS; the Village of Bolivar desires to assist businesses in the Village to address the negative financial effects of the COVID-19 pandemic with a program intended to help with expenses directly resulting from business interruption or arising from the decrease in gross revenue in connection with the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS; the State of Ohio adopted House Bill 481, which made funds available for small business programs through the Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund; and,

WHEREAS; the Council of the Village, in conjunction with the Village of Bolivar's Fiscal Office and the Village of Bolivar's Mayor's Office will administer this grant program.

NOW THEREFORE, THE VILLAGE OF BOLIVAR HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section I: The Council of the Village of Bolivar hereby establishes and creates a reimbursing grant program for Village businesses that are impacted by COVID-19, to be funded by the House Bill 481 Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund and administered by the Bolivar Mayor's Office in conjunction with the Bolivar Fiscal Office, and the Council of the Village.

Section II: Attached hereto and incorporated herein are the terms and conditions for the program.

Section III: This Resolution is to take effect at the earliest date permitted by law.
