

ORDINANCE # O-16-2021

AN ORDINANCE OF INTENT TO SELL MUNICIPALLY OWNED PERSONAL PROPERTY NOT NEEDED FOR PUBLIC USE, OR IS OBSOLETE OR UNFIT FOR THE USE FOR WHICH IT WAS ACQUIRED PURSUANT TO SECTION 721.15 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Section 721.01 of the Ohio Revised Code provides in part that, municipal corporations have special power to sell personal property belonging to the municipal corporation, when such personal property is not needed for any municipal purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council of the Village of Bolivar, Ohio has determined the 1997 Ingersoll – Rand Air compressor Premier Series is no longer needed for public use or is obsolete or unfit for the use for which it was acquired.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Village Council of the Village of Bolivar, Ohio as follows:

SECTION 1: The Village Council of the Village of Bolivar, Ohio hereby expresses its intent to sell personal property, regardless of its value, acquired for the use of municipal officers and departments, and road machinery, equipment, tools or supplies, which is not needed for public use, or is obsolete or unfit for the use for which it was acquired.

SECTION 2: That pursuant to Section 721.15 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Village Administrator is authorized to take action to facilitate the sale of the 1997 Ingersoll – Rand Air Compressor Premier series. Council may by motion, establish a minimum price that will be accepted for specific items and may establish other terms and conditions for the particular sale, including, but not limited to, requirements for pick-up or delivery, method of payment and sales tax.

SECTION 3: All Ordinances or Resolutions or parts thereof inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately as permitted by law.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, and its immediate passage is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Bolivar, Ohio, for the reason that it is necessary for the Village of Bolivar to periodically inventory Village property and determine the

necessity or lack thereof and maintain fiscal responsibility for the residents. Provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to or appointed to council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval.
