

ORDINANCE # O-23-2021

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FISCAL OFFICER OF THE VILLAGE OF BOLIVAR TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE VILLAGE OF BOLIVAR; VILLAGE OF ZOAR; LAWRENCE TOWNSHIP, TUSCARAWAS COUNTY, OHIO; AND BOLIVAR VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT, INC. AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Village Council of the Village of Bolivar, Ohio as follows:

SECTION 1: WHEREAS, The Mayor and Fiscal Officer of the Village of Bolivar are hereby authorized to enter into the attached agreement for fire and emergency/rescue (ambulance) protection for the benefit of the Village residents and businesses and for the benefit of persons living in or traveling through the Village of Bolivar, pursuant to the terms and conditions of the contract hereto and incorporated herein.

SECTION 2: All Ordinances or Resolutions or parts thereof inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately as permitted by law.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, and its immediate passage is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Bolivar, Ohio, for the reason that it is necessary to ensure no interruption in the fire and emergency/rescue (ambulance) protection for the benefit of the Village residents and businesses and for the benefit of persons living in or traveling through the Village of Bolivar. Provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to or appointed to council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval.
