

ORDINANCE # R-18-2021

A RESOLUTION OF INTENT TO SELL MUNICIPALLY OWNED PERSONAL PROPERTY NOT NEEDED FOR PUBLIC USE, OR IS OBSOLETE OR UNFIT FOR THE USE FOR WHICH IT WAS ACQUIRED PURSUANT TO SECTION 721.15 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE.

WHEREAS, Section 721.01 of the Ohio Revised Code provides in part that, municipal corporations have special power to sell personal property belonging to the municipal corporation, when such personal property is not needed for any municipal purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council of the Village of Bolivar, Ohio has determined the 2014 Dodge Charger vehicle is no longer needed for public use or is obsolete or unfit for the use for which it was acquired.

WHEREAS, the Village Council of the Village of Bolivar, Ohio wishes to establish a minimum price of \$10,000.00 and to advertise the vehicle on govdeals.com.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Village Council of the Village of Bolivar, Ohio as follows:

SECTION 1: The Village Council of the Village of Bolivar, Ohio hereby expresses its intent to sell personal property, regardless of its value, acquired for the use of municipal officers and departments, and road machinery, equipment, tools or supplies, which is not needed for public use, or is obsolete or unfit for the use for which it was acquired.

SECTION 2: That pursuant to Section 721.15 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Village Administrator is authorized to take action to facilitate the sale of the 2014 Dodge Charger vehicle.

SECTION 3: Council has established a minimum price of \$10,000.00 and will advertise the vehicle on govdeals.com.

SECTION 4: Council may establish other terms and conditions for the particular sale, including, but not limited to, requirements for pick-up or delivery, method of payment and sales tax.

SECTION 5: All Ordinances or Resolutions or parts thereof inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately as permitted by law.
