VILLAGE OF BOLIVAR SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING

July 18, 2022

The Bolivar Village Council met in special session at Village Hall on Monday, **July 18th**, 2022. The sole purpose of this meeting was 1.) Discuss and hire a fiscal officer/ clerk for the Village of Bolivar. The notice was printed in The Times Reporter detailing the purposes. The meeting was called to order by the mayor at 6:30 pm. The Pledge of Allegiance was said. White opened the meeting with a prayer. Finlayson, Lawver, White, Oberlin, and Diveley all answered yes to roll call.

Mayor Lang noted that he conducted interviews with Will Bellinger, Ted Findlayson, and Matt Judy of applicants for the fiscal officer position last Monday. He noted that all four were in agreement to hire Barb Kline, that she had impressed all of them during her interview. Findlayson and Bellinger agreed. Lang noted that Kline had worked in the finance field in collections handling accounts worth millions and millions of dollars for many year. The Mayor distributed her resume to the rest of council, so they could view her resume. Lang noted they had 12 applicants for the position. The four of them then wittled the group down to five and then settled on Kline as the best candidate for the position. Lang asked if there was any discussion necessary or whether or not any of the council members who hadn't set in on the interviews had any questions. Oberlin ask Kline if she was familiary with the UAN system. Lang interjected and said that was one of the most impressive things in the view interview committee about Barb, because she was the first candidate they ever had that went out to the township and asked them to view the UAN. She wanted to make sure it was a system she would be able to learn and use, and she had determined it was something she could pickup quickly. Lang also noted that none of the candidates had any government experience. Lang asked if any of the other council members had any questions. Dively asked if she was retired, and Kline noted she had retired from Synchrony.

Bellinger said he was recommending a rate of pay of \$19 an hour and give her 30 hours a week for the next two months and then drop back to 25hrs a week until the year end. We will increase her hours at year end, when there is more to do. Motion to suspend the rules made by Findalyson and seconded by Oberlin. Motion to hire Barb Kline as Fiscal Officer/Clerk by an emergency with a rate of pay of \$19 an hour for 30 hrs a week for the first two months made by Lawver and seconded by White. Roll Call: All yes Ordinance O-28-2022 passed. Her effective date will be July 19th, 2022.

The mayor stated that the next regular council meeting will be held on 8-1-2022, however council would be conducting a work session directly after the special meeting to discuss water rules and rates of pay for the employees. He asked for a motion to adjourn. White made the motion to adjourn and it was seconded by Bellinger. Roll Call: All yes. Meeting adjourned.
